- VD (6, 2) 1 Jones's Ch. Newlin Preston To Clairdale, stallion quality male who was shown in super condition. Lovely head with a soft expression and free from frown. Dark brown eye, well placed leathers. Good length of neck flowing into well laid shoulders & good angulated quarters & firm top line which was held on the move. Moved with drive & determination. BVD
- 2 Peterson's Troopersway Gladiator JW Sh.CM, this boy never lets his handler down he gives his all & enjoys every moment of his time in the ring. Shown in super condition, moves soundly fore & aft, & presents a super outline when stacked. He has a good spring of rib & nicely angulated. Masculine head but not overdone, good reach of neck & correct lay of shoulder.

- SVD (1) 1 Dawson & Goodall's Ch. Janfrey Randal Upon Rundle JW Sh. CM, a true gentleman through & through, never lets his handler down & his age does not show when moving around the ring, he could show some of the youngsters how it is done! Nice head with a soft expression, good reach of neck flowing into laid back of shoulder. Lovely outline when stacked. Has good reach & drive covering the ground with ease.
- MPD (4) 1 Jones & Jepson's Eardley Well Read Fred, smart compact tri

- dog with a masculine head but not overdone, dark eye with kind expression. Good reach of neck flowing into well laid back shoulders & level topline. Well muscled hindquarters which he used to his advantage. Has a bright future Im sure.
- 2 Murphy's Bayard Seal Of Approval At Rhosyndu, would prefer a softer expression, nice dark eye, leathers well set on. Slightly larger to 1, good reach of neck, level topline, good hindquarters, moved ok 3)McBain & Stevens's Maplelayne Serendipitous (A.I.) TAF
- PD (1) 1 Jones & Jepson's Eardley Trot On, this young lad is an ultra smart tri, with the most lovely head & soft expression, good front with good round bone & nice tight feet. Good reach of neck & lay of shoulder, firm topline, well sprung ribs. Has a lovely profile on the move. Moved soundly fore & aft. Shown in excellent in condition which i would not expect less from this winning kennel. He impressed me in the challenge that he was awarded the CC & BPD. I am sure this lad will gain his title in the future. Later on was awarded BIS & BPIS
- JD (6, 2) 1 Taylor's Rosanka O'Neal By Deaconfield, this dog i have liked from the ringside & did not dispoint me today. He has the loveliest of heads with a melting soft expression, with good pigmentation. Has a good neck & shoulder, straight in front with good bone & tight feet. His topline is ok but would like him to be shorter coupled & more spring of rib, but this could develop with maturity. Moved well.
- 2 Jones's Clairdale Grantchester, has a nice houndy impression, nice shaped head with a pleasing expression, good pigmentation, well set leathers. Good reach of neck, well angulated front & back, level toppling, good tail set with good carriage. Moved well fore and aft. Close decision with 1.
- 3 Wigstead's Lilleagle Jeremy Fisher With Bellenza
- YD (3) 1 Lewis's Fallowfield Romeo, lovely balanced head with a soft expression & dark eye, ears well placed with good length. Clean neck flowing into good lay of shoulder, good depth of rib & sprung ribs. Straight legs with good feet. Strong loin, well muscled rear & good tail set. Firm topline which is held on the move, moved with drive. Pleased to award him the RCC.
- 2 Wigstead's Lilleagle Jeremy Fisher With Bellenza, well up to size, has a well shaped skull & jaw with correct ear set, would like more length of upper arm, holds top line well stacked & moving but not the reach in front due to upper arm length, well set tail, sound quarters, show in good

condition.

2 Jones's Clairdale Fusilier, this smart tri has a gentle soft expression with dark eye & correct head shape, lovely to go over on the table & is of correct size. Moved well fore and aft.

3 Hardisty's Blunderhall Jacks The Lad JW

OD (2) 1 Philpott's Charterwood Chancellor, lovely masculine dog of quality, lovely shaped head with a soft appealing expression, excellent bone, legs & tight feet. He is rather tense when stacked but loosens up when he moves with a level topline. Good tail carriage. Good quarters which he uses to his advantage.

2 Ch. Fallowfield Fellman, A compact, sturdy dog of quality, head of good length with a well defined stop. Lovely dark big eyes with soft expression. Straight front, good lay of shoulder, level topline, well let down hocks, sound movement, close decision to 1.

Has correct amount of bone for a bitch & good tight feet. Moves with a free flowing stride unfortunate to meet 1.

2 Ambridge's Tiger Lilly Blossom, Femine head, has good eye colour for a tan/white with a good eye shape. God width & depth of muzzle, ear set low, good front, depth & width of chest. Level top line, slightly long in coupling. Good hind quarters. Moved with reach & drive.

MPB (7, 2) 1 Philpott's Charterwood Impact, what can i say about this puppy, it was her first show & she just stole my heart & one i would of loved to taken home. T/w bitch with the most exquisite feminine head & expression, with excellent dark eye & pigmentation. Beautifully balaced, with a lovely reach of neck flowing into good lay of shoulder. Good round bone with excellent tight feet. Good depth of chest with well sprung ribs. Good turn of stifle. Well muscled for one so young. Straight front on the move and used her hindquarters with drive. Considered her for the RCC but immaturity at the end of the day had to give way, but I am sure this beauty has a very bright future.BPB & RBPIS

Nicely let down leathers. Level top line, slightly long in coupling but overall balance good. Well muscled inner thigh with good turn of stifle, moved around the ring effortlessly. One to watch for the future. 2 Wright & Mitchell's Parkebreeway Parsnip At Huntshill, stronger head
- than 1 but still feminine, short backed with level topline, good tail set. Well muscled thighs. Moved slightly close behind.

- JB (5,1) 1 Hardisty's Blunderhall Saucy Sally JW, ultra smart tri bitch with the most appealing feminine head with lovely round eye & excellent pigmentation. Well placed ears with good length. Nicely balanced compact bitch. Ample neck with well laid back shoulders & good bend of stifle. Correct front & feet. Eye catching on the move. Well deserved RCC.
- 2 Philpott's Charterwood Hostess, compact smart trip, nicely balanced head with dark eye. Correctly placed set leathers. Reachy neck into good shoulders. Clean straight front & good topline. Carries stern correctly & sound movement.

- YB (2) 1 Jones & Jepson's Eardley Smartypants (A.I.), loved her size & type with attractiive head, dark eye & soft expression, she has a nice outline, topline & tailset. Moves out with a good stride.
- NB (6, 3) 1 Kingsland's Maplelayne Have Patience With Redcap (A.I) 2 Whitton's Alibor Genesis Of Haggatty, tri bitch which is well put together, has enough bone & nice feet. Good head & expression well constructed front with enough ribbing. Just showing her immaturity at present but sure it will all come together as she matures.

- GB (6,1) 1 Lewis's Velenco True Love For Fallowfield, pretty broken tri bitch, has a lovely well arched neck, flowing into a level topline, good tail set. She has ample forehand, good depth of chest, stifle well bent, moved with ease.

- 2 Dawson, Goodall & Harrison's Rundle Lovelace, open marked trip bitch, with a pretty head, good neck & shoulder, sound mover with scope.

- PGB (3,1) 1 Langman's Madika High Flyer At Bonwillan, broken tri bitch with a feminine head & soft expression. Compact in her proportions with a nice reach of neck which flows into a level topline & good depth of chest & spring of rib. Uses her rear angulation to drive around the ring. 2 Kingsland's Brimbleway Galaxy Bar For Redcap smart tri with pretty head & dark eye. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulder, good muscle tone with good angulation. Moved soundly
- MLB (3,1) 1 Scarlett's Rossut Vestry With Michelroy JW, a smart blanket tri bitch with a slightly larger mould, pleasing for type & outline, has a well proportioned head, nicely arched neck, well balanced in her angulation, moved out wel, shown in lovely condition.

 2 Webster's Michelroy Pimpernell With Houndscoast JW, t/w bitch who has matured nicely. Sweetest of expression with a kind dark eye & good pigmentation. Good shoulders leading into a level topline which she held of the move. Good movement fore & aft. Unlucky to meet 1 who was on her top form.
- LB (8,1) 1 Philpott's Charterwood Black Opal, this bitch i think has been overlooked on several occasions she is a lovely quality tri bitch which has great appeal, for me she is a true english beagle old style which i feel we have lost a lot in the breed over the recent years, she is well made throughout with a feminine head, dark eye & good pigmentation, has a lovely reach of neck flowing into a well laid back should, with a level topline which is held on the move, has a good tail set, she is good fore & aft with strong hindquarters which she used to her advantage. She did drop her tail at one point in the challenge due to the noisey floor but pulled herself back . I was delighted to award her the BCC & RBIS. 2 Lewis's Fallowfield Chelsey, good overall type, has a nice feminine head, with a good reach of neck, well laid shoulders, super depth with good round bone, level topline, moved with soundness & drive. 3 Jones & Jepson's Canowindra Ooh La La For Eardley
- OB (1) 1 Whitton's Jalhar New Lease Of Life With Haggatty, standing alone this tri bitch has a pleasing head, dark eye with good pigmentation

& well set ears. Level topline with good tail set & moved soundly.
